

JUST METAPHORS, OR EXTRAORDINARY EVENTS?

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Catholic Biblical Prophecy

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Luke 21:25 "And there will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and upon the earth distress of nations in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves,

26 men fainting with fear and with foreboding of what is coming on the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

- 27 And then they will see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.
- 28 Now when these things begin to take place, look up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

Luke 21:29 And he told them a parable: "Look at the fig tree, and all the trees; 30 as soon as they come out in leaf, you see for yourselves and know that the summer is already near. 31 So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that the kingdom of God is near. 32 Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away till all has taken place. 33 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

Just How Powerful is Our Omnipotent God?

It's easy for people attempting to imagine God's omnipotence as an extension of what we know. Therefore, God may be conceived as some type of extreme superman, perhaps coupled with our most powerful technology. Such conceptions don't even begin to conceptualize the assume power of God that extends from the greatest planet to the tiniest atom.

Colossians 1:16 for in him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. **17** He is before all things, and **in him all things hold together.**

Sirach 43:26b ... by his word all things hold together.

Hebrews 1:3 He reflects the glory of God and bears the very stamp of his nature, **upholding the universe by his word of power**.

2 Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a loud noise, and the elements will be dissolved with fire, and the earth and the works that are upon it will be burned up.

God is infinitely more powerful than what most moderns imagine. Shaking the earth or moving a few planets isn't beyond his ability.

The Physical Creation is Dynamically Impacted by Human Sin

Romans 8:19 For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God; **20** for the creation was subjected to futility, not of its own will but by the will of him who subjected it in hope; **21** because the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to decay and obtain the glorious liberty of the children of God. **22** We know that the whole creation has been groaning with labor pains together until now.

Isaiah 24:3 The earth shall be utterly laid waste and utterly despoiled; for the LORD has spoken this word. **4** The earth mourns and withers, the world languishes and withers; the heavens languish together with the earth. **5** The earth lies polluted under its inhabitants; for they have transgressed the laws, violated the statutes, broken the everlasting covenant. **6** Therefore a curse devours the earth, and its inhabitants suffer for their guilt; therefore the inhabitants of the earth are scorched, and few men are left.

Old & New Testament Descriptions of Extraordinary Events

Job 9:5 he who removes mountains, and they know it not, when he overturns them in his anger; 6 who shakes the earth out of its place, and its pillars tremble;

7 who commands the sun, and it does not rise; who seals up the stars;

8 who alone stretched out the heavens, and trampled the waves of the sea;

9 who made the Bear and Orion, the Pleiades and the chambers of the south;

10 who does great things beyond understanding, and marvelous things without number.

Isaiah 24:19 The earth is utterly broken, the earth is rent asunder, the earth is violently **shaken.** 20 The earth staggers like a drunken man, it sways like a hut; its transgression lies heavy upon it, and it falls, and will not rise again.

21 On that day the LORD will punish the host of heaven, in heaven, and the kings of the earth, on the earth.

23 Then the moon will be confounded, and the sun ashamed; for the LORD of hosts will reign on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem and before his elders he will manifest his glory.

Revelation 6:12 When he opened the sixth seal, I looked, and behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth, the full moon became like blood, 13 and the stars of the sky fell to the earth as the fig tree sheds its winter fruit when shaken by a gale; 14 the sky vanished like a scroll that is rolled up, and every mountain and island was removed from its place. 15 Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the generals and the rich and the strong, and every one, slave and free, hid in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains, 16 calling to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of him who is seated on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb;

17 for the great day of their wrath has come, and who can stand before it?"

Revelation 8:12 The fourth angel blew his trumpet, and a third of the sun was struck, and a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of their light was darkened; a third of the day was kept from shining, and likewise a third of the night.

Revelation 16:17 The seventh angel poured his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple, from the throne, saying, "It is done!"

- 18 And there were flashes of lightning, voices, peals of thunder, and a great earthquake such as had never been since men were on the earth, so great was that earthquake.
- 19 The great city was split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell, and God remembered great Babylon, to make her drain the cup of the fury of his wrath.

- **Isaiah 13:10** For the stars of the heavens and their constellations will not give their light; the sun will be dark at its rising and the moon will not shed its light.
- 11 I will punish the world for its evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; I will put an end to the pride of the arrogant, and lay low the haughtiness of the ruthless.
- 12 I will make men more rare than fine gold, and mankind than the gold of Ophir.
- 13 Therefore I will make the heavens tremble, and the earth will be shaken out of its place, at the wrath of the LORD of hosts in the day of his fierce anger.
- **Isaiah 34:1** Draw near, O nations, to hear, and hearken, O peoples! Let the earth listen, and all that fills it; the world, and all that comes from it.

Joel 3: 15 The sun and the moon are darkened, and the stars withdraw their shining. 16 And the LORD roars from Zion, and utters his voice from Jerusalem, and the heavens and the earth shake. But the LORD is a refuge to his people, a stronghold to the people of Israel.

Matthew 24:29 "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

Mark 13:24 "But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, 25 and the stars will be falling from heaven, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. 26 And then they will see the Son of man coming in clouds with great power and glory.

Acts 2:19 And I will show wonders in the heaven above and signs on the earth beneath, blood, and fire, and vapor of smoke; 20 the sun shall be turned into darkness and the moon into blood, before the day of the Lord comes, the great and manifest day.

Isaiah 2:12 For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low: 13 And upon all the cedars of Lebanon, that are high and lifted up, and upon all the oaks of Bashan, 14 And upon all the high mountains, and upon all the hills that are lifted up, 15 And upon every high tower, and upon every fenced wall, 16 And upon all the ships of Tarshish, and upon all pleasant pictures.

17 And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made low: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. 18 And the idols he shall utterly abolish.

19 And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

- 13 The LORD also thundered in the heavens, and the Most High uttered his voice, hailstones and coals of fire. 14 And he sent out his arrows, and scattered them; he flashed forth lightnings,

and routed them. 15 Then the channels of the sea were seen, and the foundations of the world were laid bare, at thy rebuke, O LORD, at the blast of the breath of thy nostrils.

Just metaphors without any historical, or futuristic basis?

The metaphor interpretation of these verses is adopted by most scripture scholars. This is a reasonable assumption given the fact that such descriptions seem impossible based on the widely-held assumptions by astrophysicists, geologists, astronomers, and others, that we live in a fixed and stable universe primarily governed by gravity. Therefore, all the cosmic descriptions are assumed metaphors of for "earth-shaking" historical events, like the fall of an empire.

What if there really were literal "earth-shaking" events that coincided with the fall of ancient empires? If that were the case, then historians and experts in mythology would need to pay much closer attention to the descriptions left to us by the ancients both in the scriptures and in ancient writings, including pictographs and petroglyphs.

If the case for an electric universe is true, then Newtonian physics, our understanding of astrophysics, ancient earth, human history, the theory of evolution and uniformitarianism, along with the biblically prophesied future would need comprehensive re-evaluation. Unfortunately, the information on the possibility of an electric universe is often ignored.

Resources for Investigating Ancient & Future Catastrophic Events

I am far from agreeing with everything from Velikovsky or the Thunderbolt Project. Yet, they are informative enough to prompt open-mindedness as future research and space explorations reveal more precise information about the structure and history of our universe. Our biblical interpretations may need updating in light of more accurate scientific theories.

Worlds in Collision (2009 version) and Earth in Upheaval by Immanuel Velikovsky Velikovosky engaged in a ten-year interdisciplinary study of ancient catastrophism, which was documented in ancient historical documents. As a Jew, he was interested in comparing the history of Israel in the Old Testament writings and the Talmud with documents in multiple languages worldwide.

He claimed that the real meaning of the Hebrew prophets Isaiah, Amos, Joel, and Micah refer to an actual cosmic catastrophe, including a polar reversal and movement of the terrestrial axis. After Albert Einstein's death, Veilikovsky's book was found open on his desk. Veilikovsky discussed his theories with Einstein on several occasions.

Archbishop Fulton Sheen, On the Demonic

"Darwin saw catastrophe as the chief adversary of his theory of new species. Scientists today generally agree that there have been catastrophes in the evolution of the planets as well as life.

Immanuel Veilkovsky, in his *Earth in Upheaval*, put it in picturesque language: 'The past of manking must now be viewed in the light of the experience of Hiroshima and no longer from the portholes of the Beagle.'

The universe, as well as man on this tiny earth, are not as they ought to be. Something has happened to both. There are discords in the universe just as there are complexes in the heart of man. **Planets bombard one another** as man does violence to this brother."

Historical Voices

Plato, Timaeus

"There have been, and will be again, many destructions of mankind arising out of many causes; the greatest have been brought about by the agencies of fire and water, and other lesser ones by innumerable other causes. There is a story, which even you have preserved, that once upon a time Paethon, the son of Helios, having yoked the steeds in his father's chariot, because he was not able to drive them in the path of his father, burnt up all that was upon the earth, and was himself destroyed by a thunderbolt.

Now this has the form of a myth, but really signifies a declination of the bodies moving in the heavens around the earth, and a great conflagration of things upon the earth, which recurs after long intervals;"

Plato's succinct comments provide an often overlooked example of how to deconstruct and interpret myths to discern the thoughts and events that gave stimulus to create the legends,

St. Augustine, City of God, chapter 8

"Who can number the multitude of portents recorded in profane histories? ... when it pleased Him who with sovereignty and supreme power regulates all He has created, a star conspicuous among the rest by its size and splendor changed ... the order and law of its course! Certainly that phenomenon disturbed the canons of the astronomers."

Eusebius, *Ecclesiastical History*, 9.7.2 (Copy of a message from a Roman Emperor) "the earth .. is shaken from its lowest depths with a terrible tremor, and that the mountains upon it ... sink into the opening chasms. No one is ignorant that all these, and evils still worse than these, have oftentimes happened hitherto."

Sister Lucy: An Important Contemporary Voice
