SUMMARY

In this episode, Steve Wood prepares listeners for what he calls an upcoming cultural and spiritual flashpoint: Disclosure Day, tied to the release of a new film by Steven Spielberg on June 12, 2026. Advance reports claim the film will reveal that extraterrestrial life exists and is already present on Earth, accompanied by government disclosures related to UAPs and UFOs.

Rather than approaching this topic through speculation or fear, the episode offers a biblical framework to understand what is happening. Scripture reveals that non-human intelligent beings do exist—but they are not extraterrestrials from another planet. They are interdimensional beings, identified in the Bible as fallen angels. By understanding protology (the beginning) and eschatology (the end), Christians can discern current events without being deceived by signs, wonders, or advanced technologies presented as salvation or progress.

KEY INSIGHTS

- The Bible already explains non-human intelligence—this is nothing new.
- UFO/UAP phenomena are best understood through a biblical, not extraterrestrial, lens.
- The days of Noah provide the prophetic blueprint for the end times.
- Advanced technology and supernatural signs are tools of deception, not proof of truth. Cultural events and media may be conditioning the world for spiritual counterfeit realities.
- Discernment, rooted in Scripture, is essential to avoid end-times deception.
